

- o Have participants register online and receive a confirmation email instead of using paper print-outs
- o Reduce carbon footprint:
  - Set up a carpool or utilize a ride-share program for attendees to get to the event
  - Encourage your group to walk to their meeting spaces instead of driving—Make it fun and set up a pedometer challenge
  - Fort Collins has a <u>Bike Library-</u>Encourage participants to take part
  - Make a carbon off-set carbon site available on your registration page through www.ColoradoCarbonFund.org
- Encourage participants to bring a water bottle and/or coffee mug to refill instead of using disposable cups
- o Use white boards and chalk boards for meetings instead of paper flipcharts
- o Provide bulk meals/food that require less packaging (i.e. cream, sugar, condiments)
- o Utilize the single stream recycling services provided in meeting rooms and at meal times
- o Encourage guests to re-use towels in sleeping rooms to save water
- o Close curtains/blinds during the day to lower energy costs and keep your meeting room cool
- o Return meal cards to the front desk at the end of your conference to be recycled
- Return portfolios/name badges to the registration table at the end of your conference for reuse

## Did you know that...

- o CSU is the only Colorado school named in Enviance Inc.'s "Sustainable 16" Universities in 2012
- Our campus is only one square mile and most meeting space is a short 7 to 10 minute walk away
- o Housing & Dining Services purchases renewable energy in all public areas
- o CSU is bike-friendly, with a Silver Level League of American Bicyclist certification
- Over half of our classrooms offer SMART classroom technology encouraging less paper waste
- o Our bins are **single-stream**: all items can go into the same bin- no need to sort
- Our trayless dining system reduces plate waste by 50% and saves thousands of gallons of water
- Each year 7,200 gallons of used cooking oil are collected to be refined to create biodiesel
- o **Pulpers** compost food and paper waste—reducing waste stream by up to 70% and water usage by 80%
- Over 20% of the food served in our dining centers is organic or locally grown/supplied
- o Aspen Hall is **LEED Gold Certified** and features an on-site thermal plant
